Day 1 | Welcome to the Eternal City of Rome

Day 2 | Vatican City and Rome with a Local

Day 3 | The Chianti Hills to Florence

Day 4 | Florence, Birthplace of the Renaissance



Explore Florence with Insight Choice. Choose to visit the Accademia Museum and see Michelangelo's David. Spend time gazing at statues such as Neptune and Hercules and Cacus along the front of the Palazzo Vecchio.

Alternatively, take a stroll with your Travel Director to enjoy a typical Italian treat in a local cafe. This city is renowned for its intricate crafts, so later in the day, enjoy a demonstration of traditional leatherwork and goldsmithing.

Day 8 | Sorrento on the coast

This optional experience is weather dependent and may be replaced by a minibus tour of the Island with a visit to Anacapri and either the Villa San Michele or the Anacapri chairlift.

This small family-run farm on the slopes of the volcano is one of the world's only producers of Piennolo tomatoes, an endangered fruit that only thrives in the fertile volcanic soil. Each harvest is sustainably farmed and cared for by the extended Barone family, who all work here. Be sure to savor the unique flavors of this rare tomato during a truly unique Farm-to-Table lunch. Your journey continues to Rome. In the evening, enjoy an elegant dinner with local wine at a Roman restaurant. As you dine, enjoy a private performance of popular songs and arias from some of Italy's best-loved operas.
