## Day 1 | Welcome to Athens

## Day 3 | The Pinnacles of Meteora



With your Local Expert, visit the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Meteora, meaning 'suspended in the air.' Visit one of the monasteries, that adds to the strange and beautiful landscape and enjoy stunning views over the Peneios Valley. The rest of the day is at your leisure. Why not explore with a relaxed walk on the nature trails? Alternatively, you may wish to visit the Natural History Museum.

#### Day 4 | The Sacred Way and onto Olympia
