Day 1 | Fashionable Helsinki

Day 2 | Day at Leisure in Helsinki



Helsinki is yours to stroll leisurely through Finland's quaint capital or take the opportunity to cruise across the Baltic Sea to Estonia where you will visit Tallinn, its fairytale capital city. Take in the panoramic views from Toompea Hill before visiting the market square with its old German weighing house, pharmacy and Town Hall. Enjoy time at leisure this afternoon to browse Tallinn's shops, famous for fine amber and silver jewelry before returning to Helsinki.

A Day in Estonia - Take a day trip to Estonia, the smallest and northernmost Baltic state. Cross the Baltic Sea to Tallinn, a UNESCO World Heritage-listed capital. With a Local Expert, explore the medieval Old Town, still encircled by remnants of its ancient city wall. Discover its cobbled streets, medieval buildings, and charming shops. After the guided tour, enjoy free time to shop or have lunch before returning to Helsinki. On the ferry, savor a buffet dinner of fresh Finnish and Nordic cuisine, with drinks included—a relaxing end to your day.

Day 3 | Helsinki and Baltic Cruise to Stockholm



Explore Helsinki, the trendsetting city of top fashion and design, alongside a Local Expert. Wander through the aromatic stalls of a traditional food market and sample local produce like liquorice or smoked reindeer. This afternoon, board your cruise ship for the overnight voyage to Sweden. Day 4 | Stockholm, City of Islands

OPTIONAL EXPERIENCES:

Vasa Galleon - When the Vasa was launched in 1628, it was arguably the world's most powerful warship. Bristling with 64 cannon and carrying some 300 men, it was built to strike the fear of God into the enemy. Unfortunately, it sank on its maiden voyage. Raised from Stockholm harbor in 1961, this grand galleon remains almost wholly preserved, along with 700 wooden sculptures and ornaments. Your visit will provide a unique insight into early shipbuilding techniques and everyday life on board a 17c naval vessel. Adult: 57.00 EUR

Day 5 | Stockholm



Stockholm, beautifully situated across 14 islands, blends medieval alleyways with cutting-edge Scandinavian design. Begin your day with Insight Choice. Dive into the glitz and legacy of Sweden's most iconic pop export at ABBA The Museum—an interactive experience celebrating the music, style and global impact of the beloved quartet. Alternatively, explore the spirited side of Swedish culture at the lively Spirit Museum, where art and artifacts trace the country's long and complex relationship with alcohol, from traditional aquavit to contemporary craft distilling.

Day 6 | Stockholm to Oslo



Journey past Lake Vänern, the largest lake in Sweden, and enjoy a scenic drive through Norway's forested landscapes to Oslo. On arrival, enjoy some free time to explore—visit the harbourfront Aker Brygge district with its waterside cafes and boutiques, or see the striking modern architecture of the Oslo Opera House. In the evening, dine with your fellow travelers at a local restaurant.

Day 7 | Cosmopolitan Oslo



Explore Oslo with your Local Expert, uncovering the city's royal history and striking contemporary design. Later, you may wish to explore Oslo City Hall, where the prize ceremony takes place each year, or join an Optional Experience to Holmenkollen, home to the world's most modern ski jump and panoramic views of the Oslofjord.

The expeditions of Fridtjof Nansen and Roald Amundsen come to life in the interactive exhibitions of this museum, which also houses the Gjøa, the first ship to navigate the entire Northwest Passage.

Norwegians Are Born With Skis On Their Feet - Enjoy spectacular panoramic views of Oslo ski jump. At 1,400 feet in the air, our Local Expert will share 4,000 years of skiing history with you in this ultra-modern skiing museum.

Day 8 | From Norway to Denmark
